CORRUPTION INVESTIGATION DIVISION

1.0 Post: Investigator

1.1 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

QUALIFICATIONS: A Bachelor's degree in Law, Accountancy, Banking, Finance, Audit, Forensic Accounting; Financial Mathematics or Mathematics with Finance;

or

An alternative qualification acceptable to the Commission.

Experience: Candidates should have at least three years post qualification work experience in auditing; banking; investigation or prosecution of criminal, financial or economic crimes

2.0 Post: Digital Forensic Expert

2.1 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

QUALIFICATIONS: A. A Bachelor's degree in Computer Forensics, or Digital Forensics or related fields from a recognized institution or an alternative qualification acceptable to the Commission; and

B. At least three years' post qualification experience in computer investigation and analysis and exposure to computer forensics tools.

Possession of certification in the related field would be an advantage.

Candidates must be conversant with the relevant prevailing Legislations;

Candidates should produce written evidence of experience/knowledge claimed.

3.0 Post: Corruption Prevention Officer –(Systems Enhancement)

3.1 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Or

Public officers holding a Diploma with five years' working experience in the field of either Finance or Accountancy or Management or Engineering or Human Resources from a recognized institution or an alternative qualification acceptable to the Commission.

4.0 Post: Corruption Prevention Officer –(Community Relations)

4.1 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

QUALIFICATIONS: A Bachelor's degree in Communication or Community/Public Relations or Education or Sociology or Psychology from a recognized institution or an alternative qualification acceptable to the Commission.

Or

Public officers holding a Diploma with five years' working experience in the field of either Finance or Accountancy or Management or Engineering or Human Resources from a recognized institution or an alternative qualification acceptable to the Commission.

5.0 Post: Multimedia Education Programme Developer

5.1 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

QUALIFICATIONS:

A. A Bachelor's degree in Graphic Design and Multimedia or related fields from a recognized institution or an alternative qualification acceptable to the Commission.

B. At least five years' post qualification experience

6.0 Post: Research and Development Officer

6.1 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

QUALIFICATIONS:

A. A degree (preferably a Masters) in Social Sciences or related fields from a recognized institution or an alternative qualification acceptable to the Commission.

B. At least three years' post qualification experience
