



Guidelines for National Anti-Corruption Fresco Competition

- 1) The competition is open to the general public.
- 2) The theme of the competition is '**Ar Mwa Koripsion Non**'.
- 3) Participation will be on a team basis comprising a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 6 participants
- 4) Participants can submit any number of entries
- 5) Participants should submit their participation forms to the ICAC by **Friday 08 July 2022**
- 6) Participants should submit their design of paintings by **Friday 29 July 2022**
- 7) The paintings should be original and not copied from any source.
- 8) Painting materials for the wall painting will be provided to registered participants.
- 9) The design of the painting should be in paper of A3 size. The name of the participants along with the contact details should be written at the back of the sheet.
- 10) Participants must not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks and rights of privacy, or any other propriety rights of a person or entity.
- 11) Winners of the competition will be offered prizes as follows:

1st Prize	Rs 25,000
2nd Prize	Rs 15,000
3rd Prize	Rs 10,000

- 12) The decision of the Jury will be binding and final.
- 13) ICAC reserves the right not to make an award following this competition.
- 14) Certificates of participation will be awarded to participants having satisfied the minimum criteria.
- 15) Participants cannot claim any remuneration if ICAC uses paintings in any form, modified or otherwise for use in its education campaigns.
